## Literacy and Numeracy Catch-Up Premium

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not reach the government's "expected standard" (previously a level 4) in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2. Schools receive an additional £500 for each pupil in year 7

### Objective

Our objective is to support year 7 pupils in securing aspirational rates of progress in Maths and English to allow them to "close the gap" with their peers.

This document details how we plan to spend this premium in 2016/17.

Maths intervention programme x 2 during the week	1:1 peer mentoring programme following Ninja Numeracy programme scheme.	Attainment in line with expected level
Literacy Intervention programme. X 2 extra sessions	Literacy intervention programme. Extra two lessons a week, with focus on the basic skills of literacy.	Attainment in line with expected level
Maths and English	Smaller class size to allow for more individualised teaching and directed support.	Increased resilience and focus shown by pupils in subjects.
Accelerated Reader	A structured programme to allow pupils independently reading practice. To test understanding through comprehension tasks.	Reading age increase and improved comprehension. Increased enjoyment of reading.
Paired Reading Programme	Individualised reading support and development.	Reading ages increase, confidence and enjoyment of reading improve.
